Market Guidelines

The POC Farmers Market is a community event promoting our local farmers, artisans and craftsman. The market is held the second Saturday of each month at the King Fisher Park Pavilion from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm.

- A vendor application form must be completed, submitted and approved by the Thursday prior to the event. Forms can be submitted to pocfarmersmarket@portoconnorchamber.com
 - Vendor Applications are only required the first time you exhibit and if you change the items you plan to sell.
- Vendor space is on a first come basis with setup starting at 6:45 am the day of the market.
- Each vendor may bring a 10x10 tent, table and chairs which can be placed next to the pavilion. The pavilion is also available for setup with table and chairs.
- Vendors selling foods prepared by a cottage production operation must adhere to all rules provided by the Texas Department of Human Services including, but not limited to, labeling requirements.
- If you have samples in disposable cups, please bring a trash can for these items to be disposed of properly.
- Ensure that your space is clean, and all items are removed when you take down your spot.
- Each vendor is responsible for collecting their own sales tax for items sold that are taxable under state law.
- All vendors must be gone by 1:00 pm

Products to Be Sold: (No wholesale retail products) All products should be homemade/designed, or home grown.

- Fresh fruits, vegetables, herbs, honey, jams, jellies, salsa, sauces, dips, cheese, eggs, bread, bakery items, plants, artwork, crochet, quilts, leather goods, pottery.
- Non-traditional items- these will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. The Farmers Market Committee will approve or deny applicants based on overall fit in the POC Farmers Market.
